
## **KPUD's 2012 Fuel Mix Chart**



## **Electricity Comes From Multiple Sources**

Klickitat PUD's diverse mix of energy sources comes mainly from the Bonneville Power Administration's resource portfolio, along with output from KPUD's McNary Hydro Fishway project.

The Washington Department of Community, Trade and Economic Development conducts an annual survey of all

electric utilities operating within the state to determine the source of the electric energy sold to the utilities' retail customers.

CTED uses the information to develop a statewide database and subsequently provides each electric utility with a "fuel mix report" listing the fuel types used in providing their electric service. ■
