GENERAL MANAGER'S REPORT TO THE BOARD For the **February 27, 2024** Meeting

AGENDA ITEMS:

- A. Professional Services Prequalification - Brandon Johnson will provide an update to the Professional Services roster for your review and approval.
- B. Prequalification of Contractors - Purchasing has received additional responses to their request for qualifications. Cynthia Bruce will provide a list of qualified contractors and request that they be added to the works rosters.
- C. Resolution 1848 Rescinding Credit Card Authority for Sohn Kartes - Cynthia Bruce will present the resolution to remove Sohn's credit card authorization since he has transitioned back to the maintenance department.
- D. WPUDA Scholarship nomination selection submission - With the change to the WPUDA annual meeting date, the scholarship nomination was delayed as well. We will have a recommendation for KPUD's nominee at the meeting.
- E. Resolution 1849- Appointment of Alternates for General Manager - Upon reviewing designated alternates for coverage during the General Manager position absence or incapacitation we found that our referenced positions were outdated. We have updated the positions of responsibility wish to rescind all outdated Resolutions.

- 1. Senate Bill 5919 / House Bill 2069 Carbon Dioxide Authority - Both bills have cleared their respective houses and the opposite house committees. I fully expect one or the other to be voted on shortly.
- 2. Conservation District Meetings - Anita Clever, Justin Beierle and I will attend the February 21 and 27 meetings. We are touching on conservation programs available to customers, projects in the local area and discussions around electric market scarcity and
