## 2015 Klickitat County Fair and Parade

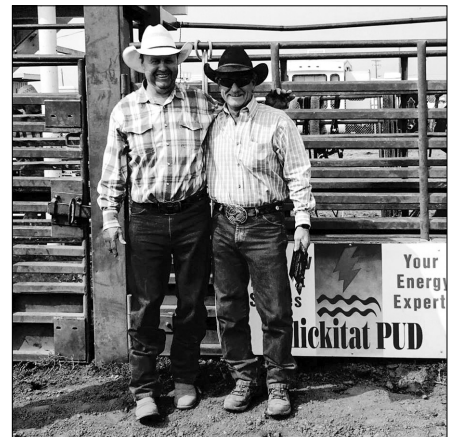
Klickitat PUD was well represented at the Klickitat County Fair and Parade. Many employees volunteered their time and energy to make the event memorable.
