# **Helping Your Community**

## Who gets help, and how does someone apply?

Applications are available at KPUD offices and are subject to review by the Ministerial Association. There are no income limits. Nominations are also accepted if you are aware of someone in financial need who may be unwilling to apply for assistance on their own.

### How can I contribute?

You can be part of Operation Warm Heart with a tax-deductible contribution of any amount. There are three easy ways to give:

- Have a small amount added to your monthly KPUD bill. Most people give just \$1 or \$2 a month.
- Make a one-time contribution of any amount. All gifts are welcome.
- Place your bill on Operation Round Up, which rounds up utility bills to the nearest dollar. Proceeds are deposited into the Operation Warm Heart fund to help families
