The Water Use Efficiency
Program was created by Washington Law, as a plan for each
water system to implement water saving activities. Part of the
plan requirements are to adopt
customer goals.

In 2022 KPUD Board of Commissioners approved Water Use Efficiency Goals for each community.

The new **Roosevelt** Water System customer goal adopted for 2022-2028 is to reduce per connection consumption 3 year average to 320 gallons or less per day even as growth occurs in the community.
