Save Energy When You Go Away on Vacation

- ▶ Keep your house cool to prevent stagnant air, high humidity and hot temperatures, where mold and mildew thrive.
- ▶ Install a programmable thermostat or timer to run the air conditioner two hours a day to keep the humidity less than 70 percent.
- ▶ Turn the breaker off to your hot water heater.
- ▶ Switch off the swimming pool heater.
- ▶ Set the refrigerator at the warmest setting.
- ▶ Unplug your television, toaster, coffee pot, iron, kitchen range, microwave, oven and other small appliances.
- ▶ Turn the water off to your washing machine so hoses don't break and flood your house.



A Mark of Excellence

You probably have seen the mark above on a number of products. Illinois-based Underwriters Laboratories (UL) is the leading third-party certification organization in the United States and North America. As a not-for-profit product safety testing and certification organization, UL has been evaluating products in the interest of public safety since 1894.



The UL mark means samples of the product met safety requirements, primarily based on UL's published standards. The mark can be found on appliances and computer equipment, furnaces and heaters, fuses, electrical panel boards, smoke detectors, life jackets, bullet-resistant glass and thousands of other products.

To determine if a product is certified by UL, look for the mark on the product, not the packaging or store display. ■
