KPUD crews grapple with snow and ice to restore power after January storms





Winter unleashed its fury for seven days in January, bringing snow and ice that knocked out electricity to much of Klickitat County and required an epic response from Klickitat PUD and others to restore power. In addition to the KPUD crews, crews from Benton PUD, Franklin PUD, Cowlitz PUD and Clallam PUD, and one construction crew from Michels Power made repairs.
