

Save Lives With One Call Before Digging

Digging into buried electric lines can cause serious injury or even death. Avoid hitting underground utilities by calling the Washington 811 service. Every utility in your area will be contacted and requested to mark their lines on your property.

No Cost Service

Submit a ticket at www.callbeforeyoudig.org/washington or call 811 at least two business days before your digging project, and all underground electric lines, water lines, sewer lines, gas lines and phone lines will be marked for free.

Follow the Law

If you damage buried utility lines, you could be required to pay hefty fines—as much as \$10,000 per violation—plus repair costs if you didn't call 811 first.

Avoid the Big Green Box

Never plant trees or shrubs near those big, green metal boxes. They are underground transformers. Klickitat PUD's lines run from the underground transformer to your home, so never dig anywhere in your yard without first calling Washington 811.
