GENERAL MANAGER'S REPORT TO THE BOARD

AGENDA ITEMS

- A. SET PUBLIC HEARING DATE & TIME, WATER & WASTE WATER RATES – Staff is asking for the Board to set the Public Hearing date for annual adjustments to water and waste water system rates for May 24, at 3:00 pm. Staff has met with representatives from about half the systems to date and will have met with representatives from all systems to discuss their respective systems and proposed rate adjustments prior to the public hearing as in past years.
- B. M McNARY TURBINE REPLACEMENT PROJECT / CRANE FAILURE – Kevin will give an update on damage to the upper and lower turbine covers. The covers contain guide bearings for the turbine shaft, as well as the wicket gate seals.
- C. EXECUTIVE SESSION 3:30 pm: CONTRACT NEGOTIATIONS – Staff will be presenting detailed proposals for power purchase agreements, as well as a potential for a renewable natural gas development / off-take proposal.
