

CUSTOMER SELF-EVALUATION CHECK-LIST

Eligibility Criteria

Single -Family Residential Service

To determine eligibility prior to submitting Advanced Meter Opt-Out Form, please check/answer the below questions. If service location does not meet eligibility criteria indicated below, customer is unable to qualify for the opt-out program.

		Is your service rated for 200 amps or less? If not, service is ineligible.
		Has your account been in good standing for the last 24 months? Not disconnected for non-payment.
		Is your meter readily accessible at all times and unobstructed? If you received an access or dangerous conditions letter from KPUD, you do not qualify.
		Is this a residential service that includes an additional separate meter? Perhaps for a garage, shed, shop, or well house on the premise with the primary residential account.
Ineligible Criteria		
If service location meets any of the criteria indicated below, customer is ineligible for opt-out program.		
	Multi- unit residential service such as a duplex, triplex or apartment building	
	Residential service from a new construction	
	Residential service has CT's as part of the metering equipment	
	Residential service with peak demand measuring more than 25kW during any billing cycle	
	Any Commercial Services (small, medium, large)	
	Any Irrigation or Industrial Service	
	Net Meter or Aggregated Metering Services	
	Temporary Services	
	Location enrolled in a Landlord Agreement	
	Vacation homes or any location with part-time occupancy	

*Customers who choose to opt-out will forego the opportunity to receive benefits through AMI metering such as, high usage notifications, data/outage alerts, and real-time meter data. They will receive the same TOU meter, but without the radio frequency transmitter. *
