
During the meter exchange, power will be out for a few minutes while the new meter is safely installed. KPUD customers do not need to be present for the meter exchange. However, Allegiant technicians will knock to notify anyone home before starting the exchange. Allegiant installers will be wearing uniforms with proper identification and will neither need nor request to enter your home.

The PUD will send notification letters or postcards ahead of deployment in your area.

AMI meters have many customer benefits, including helping KPUD identify and respond to outages faster and improving customer service by providing access to more timely power use information. Once the new meter is installed, customers will be able to access real-time usage data via KPUD's SmartHub app or online.
